COVID-19 testing update: As of yesterday (Monday, April 6) 383 tests have been performed at our Assessment Centre and in our Hospital. Currently, our Hospital team is providing care to several presumptive cases.

Planning and preparations are underway to establish a Dedicated COVID-19 Care Unit in case of an influx of COVID-19 infected patients. Our focus is to ensure the most appropriate care environment for COVID-19 infected patients, as well as the safety of staff and professional staff. More information will be issued this week.

To support safe, quality decision-making, COVID-19 test status indicators are viewable within the Meditech electronic medical record (EMR). Please refer to today's memo for more details. Staff are reminded that viewing patient information when not directly involved in the care of that patient is strictly prohibited.

Thank you for helping to preserve Personal Protective Equipment (PPE). Proper management of PPE equipment and supplies is vital to maintain their availability to all staff and professional staff throughout the COVID-19 pandemic. Answering your questions about PPE is a priority. New information resources will be provided today.
