This is the day we hoped would never come. A member of our Hospital's support staff has tested positive for COVID-19. Our thoughts are with our colleague, who is isolating at home. Please join me in hoping for a quick recovery.

Our Occupational Health & Safety team is working with the Thunder Bay District Health Unit to investigate contacts both in the community and in the Hospital. Our initial investigation has determined that there has been minimal exposure to Hospital staff and patients.

While this development is not unexpected, it is nonetheless extremely difficult to process. I recognize that a confirmed case within our own team raises fear and anxiety for many staff, professional staff, patients and community members.

Your health and safety is my top priority and I will take every possible measure to keep you safe. Today's news is a harsh reminder that no one is immune to the COVID-19 virus. We must remain vigilant with our safety protocols. We must take care of each other.
