RE: Updated Screening Protocols for Staff

Your health and safety is our utmost priority. That is why COVID-19 screening is in place at Hospital entrances. Please note that the screening algorithm has been updated as per the new medical directive for testing requirements.

## Effective tomorrow (Saturday, April 18), staff will be asked the following questions before entrance to the Hospital is permitted:

- 1. Are you experiencing **ONE** of the following symptoms: Fever, cough, difficulty breathing, muscle aches, fatigue, headache, sore throat, runny nose, chills, or gastrointestinal symptoms (eg. nausea, vomiting and/or diarrhea)
- 2. Have you traveled outside of Northwestern Ontario (Manitoba border to White River) in the last 14 days?
- 3. Have you had close contact **without PPE** with anyone with a confirmed or probable (being tested at present) case of COVID-19?
- 4. In the last 14 days, have you been diagnosed with COVID-19 by a lab test or are you waiting for results of a lab test for COVID-19?

If you answer yes to any of the above questions, you will be instructed to go home, self-isolate, contact your Staffing Department (if applicable), your Department/Manager AND Occupational Health & Safety.

In order to prevent potential staffing shortages, all staff and professional staff should consider your symptoms BEFORE leaving home and contact your staffing department or your Department/Manager right away so alternate staffing can be arranged.

These changes will be implemented at the screening stations and on the Self-Screening app. The designated screening entrances remain the same.

This new screening protocol is in place for the health and safety of all staff, professional staff, patients and the community.
