In collaboration with health system and political partners, efforts continue to increase COVID-19 testing in our community, as well as to secure supplies of in-house tests for rapid results for use in our Hospital. Results of in-house testing kits can be provided within hours, whereas the turnaround time for tests referred to Public Health Ontario Laboratories (PHOL) in Toronto is several days. Faster turnaround of test results enhance patients, staff and professional staff safety, and help to preserve Personal Protective Equipment (PPE).

Our Hospital is experiencing a shortage of in-house COVID-19 tests for rapid results. Therefore, all requests for priority in-house COVID-19 testing must again be approved by Dr. Kennedy or Dr. Ahmed. Requests should be related to absolute priority tests for which public health lab tests cannot be considered. This measure is effective immediately and will remain in place until June 4, 2020 unless otherwise notified. Only Physicians, the Director of Patient Flow & the Manger of Occupational Health and Safety (or delegates) may request a priority test.

The health and safety of patients, their families, staff, professional staff, and the community is our top priority. To help prevent the risk or spread of COVID-19, our Hospital implemented regarding the number of care partners permitted at our Hospital, in accordance with the recommendations of Ontario's Chief Medical Officer of Health. We recognize that the restrictions are difficult, and have responded to several inquiries specifically related to care partner restrictions for the Labour & Delivery and Maternal Newborn areas.
