To clarify yesterday's report, the restrictions on multiple employers have **NOT** been lifted at this time. Instead, the organization has implemented a reconsideration process for employers which pose a minimal exposure risk. Staff may make a request for reconsideration through your Manager and await approval before commencing work. Emergency orders related to long term-care and congregate care facilities, including the Transitional Care Unit at Hogarth Riverview Manor, remain in place and exceptions cannot be made at this time. We apologize for any confusion this may have caused.

In light of the Premier's announcement on Monday, June 8, 2020 that more businesses are permitted to re-open, including shopping malls, we recommend that Seasons Gift Shop prepare to re-open over the coming weeks. The Gift Shop will be staffed with paid staff only, until volunteers are permitted to return to service on-site. The recommended date for re-opening the store to customers is July 27, 2020, with reduced hours (9:00 am – 1:00 pm). If warranted, the gift shop may increase hours of opening at a later date, in consultation with the Hospital.

Yesterday, our Hospital welcomed a site visit from the Honourable Patty Hadju, Minister of Health, MPP Thunder Bay - Superior North. She visited with staff at the Medical Centre 984 Oliver Road, and Health Services Centre 1040 Oliver Road to hear stories of COVID-19 pandemic challenges, the impact to staff and operations, as well our successful strategies and collaborative approaches to ensure the safety of all staff, professional staff, patients and the community. Thank you to those who were selected to participate and represent our Hospital on such short notice. Hearing your stories incited pride and true appreciation for everyone's effort, motivation and professionalism during this difficult pandemic.
