

RE: Meetings during COVID-19

As operations at our Hospital continue to increase, your health and safety remains our utmost priority. To help prevent the risk or spread of COVID-19, meetings must respect provincial guidelines regarding Phase 2, Stage 2 of reopening.

Currently, gatherings of up to 10 people are permitted in person as long as physical distancing can be maintained. Please refer to the chart below to guide decisions regarding meetings. To allow for physical distancing, Hospital meeting rooms should be considered to only hold approximately one third of its full capacity, and no more than 10 people. If there is any doubt on the ability to maintain physical distancing, a face covering should also be worn.
