The news on Friday of the COVID-19 outbreak was concerning to many. Sincere appreciation is extended to leadership, staff and professional staff for outstanding support and professionalism at this challenging time. The status of the COVID-19 Outbreak on 1A Oncology is unchanged. Two staff members are impacted, having tested COVID-19 positive. No patients have been infected as a result. Processes are in place to minimize the number of people entering 1A Oncology at this time, including staff.

Although upsetting, outbreaks occur in hospitals and other health care facilities across the globe, and it is not unexpected that we would experience one here. We must continue to be supportive and respectful, and to recognize the impact of pandemic fatigue on ourselves and each other. We are in this together. Our collective empathy and ongoing diligence to infection control protocols will see us through this.
