RE: Implementation Locations – Level 2 Procedure Masks for all Staff

In follow up to the memo re: the mandatory use of Level 2 (or higher) procedure masks for all staff, department specific or centralized locations for staff to obtain Level 2 procedure masks will be made available as soon as possible.

Level 2 procedure masks are already available in patient care areas and inventory will be increased as required to meet demand. Further, if Stores already supplies your area with Level 2 procedure masks, that process will continue.

Areas will be stocked or delivered based on allocation and expected usage, knowing that non-clinical areas should be using no more than 1 mask per day per person onsite.

For those areas not already supplied by Stores, masks will also be available in the following locations:

- 2nd floor Billing
- 2nd floor Director area (Director admin area suite 2170)
- 3rd floor Administration (in CEO Executive Assistant office)
- Health Services Building (1040 Oliver Rd.) IT/IS, 4th floor
- ICR Discoveries/Amethyst House (290/289 Munro St.) ACT Team, 2nd floor
- Assessment Centre at Confederation College ordered/delivered by Stores

For areas not currently receiving masks from Stores, mask distribution will begin on December 2, 2020.
