COVID-19 Vaccines:

- Over 3,600 vaccines have been administered to date.
- As part of priority vaccination for Long Term Care (LTC) residents, a supply of the Moderna vaccine was delivered to the four LTC facilities in the region.
- Planning for regular shipments of vaccine and a larger space to administer vaccines efficiently.
- Prioritization of Health Care Workers as part of Phase 1 of rollout.

Community COVID-19 status:

- Community outbreaks associated with Thunder Bay District Jail and Thunder Bay Correctional Centre and the increased risk of community spread.

Physical distancing and masks:

- Enhanced safety measures for the protection of all.
