RE: COVID-19 Vaccination: Staff prioritization update

Hello, everyone. My apologies for the late day note – but I wanted to let you know we are taking actions to speed up vaccinations at TBRHSC. Our goal is to vaccinate those in the Very High Priority Group (details below) within three days.

To facilitate this, the TBRHSC COVID-19 Vaccine Clinic will extend hours from 08:00 to midnight beginning tomorrow, Thursday, February 25. To allow for the extended hours, some TBRHSC staff will be temporarily assigned from outpatient care to the Vaccine Clinic. As well, the Ambulatory Care Clinic will be closed Thursday, February 25 at 16:00 and will reopen on Tuesday, March 2 at 08:00. Patients will be notified and rescheduled.

We will continue to administer vaccines for all groups of Health Care Workers at TBRHSC within the next few weeks, provided vaccine supplies are received as anticipated and there are no changes in direction from the Ministry or Public Health. Those identified to receive their vaccines will be contacted with scheduling details.
