RE: **Isolation Shelter Overnight Waiting Area**

On March 9, 2021, an Isolation Shelter Overnight Waiting Area was created in the Forensic Mental Health (FMH) Waiting Room. This was a temporary measure to support people waiting for transportation to an Isolation Shelter.

Effective immediately, this area has been reverted to its original use. As a result, the FMH Waiting Room entrance can once again be utilized as an access route for staff working in adjacent offices and/or when responding to Emergency Codes.

Teams responding to Emergency Codes (Codes Blue, White, Alert 99) can use previously established routes including the FMH Waiting Room entrance if required.
