RE: **Safety Compliance at Entrances**

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Effective **Monday, April 26<sup>th</sup>**, the MRI Door – Staff Only Entrance will be staffed with additional screeners during peak times to help promote the importance of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) compliance.

All staff, Professional staff, students and volunteers are required to wear a mask, wear eye protection and use the hand sanitizer station upon entry to our Hospital.

As instructed by the Medical Officer of Health, all businesses and organizations located within the Thunder Bay District must adopt a policy that requires all members of the public and employees who enter or remain in an enclosed public space to wear a mask or face covering.
