RE: **Second Dose Vaccine Appointments**

Late last week, the Province of Ontario announced that any individual vaccinated on or before April 18<sup>th</sup>, 2021, is now eligible to re-book their second dose appointment to an earlier date.

This will apply to most of our Hospital staff other than the highest risk health care workers who have already received a code to reschedule their appointment.

While our Hospital's Vaccination Clinic is still completing second doses for our highest risk health care workers, a potential increase in vaccine supply will allow additional spots for some of our staff. Booking information for these clinics will be provided through a booking link once it becomes available.

Alternatively, staff are able to reschedule their second dose appointment through the Provincial booking system if they wish to attend a local pharmacy (<https://covid-19.ontario.ca/vaccine-locations>) or the Thunder Bay District Health Unit (TBDHU) Vaccination Clinic (<https://www.tbdhu.com/vaccinebooking>).

Currently, the TBDHU is booking appointments for the week of June 21<sup>st</sup>. **Hospital staff that choose to reschedule through these channels must ensure that they cancel their appointment with the Hospital's Vaccination Clinic by emailing [vaccinationclinic@tbh.net](mailto:vaccinationclinic@tbh.net).**

This will allow your spot to be allocated to another individual waiting to receive their vaccine dose. The Hospital's Vaccination Clinic hopes to release additional spots for second dose appointments very shortly, so please stay tuned for more information.
