RE: In-Person Meetings at Our Hospital

Throughout the COVID-19 pandemic, staff meetings at our Hospital have been conducted virtually via Webex. Only essential in-person meetings have been permitted, with participants following physical distancing and masking guidelines.

With many staff returning to work on site, staff vaccination rates at approximately 95%, and the low number of positive cases in our community, our Hospital will be supporting the revival of inperson meetings in alignment with our Internal Pandemic Response Level:

Green	Yellow

- Able to meet in-person at full capacity as long as distancing of 2 metres can be met.
- If distancing cannot be met, mask and goggles are required.
- Meetings must not take place around the hours of 11:30 AM to 1:30 PM, for those assigned as overflow meeting rooms.
- Meeting rooms as overflow lunch and break rooms from 11:30 AM to 1:30 PM

Orango	Red	Grey
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- No in-person meetings, unless essential. If the meeting is essential, physical distancing of 2 metres must be maintained.
- If distancing cannot be met, mask and goggles are required.
- Meeting rooms as overflow lunch and break rooms from 11:30 AM to 1:30 PM
