Did you know that in 2021, a total of 16 lives were saved in Ontario because of the generosity of seven organ donors at our Hospital? Those donors allowed four lung transplants, six kidney transplants, four liver transplants, one heart transplanted, and one pancreas transplanted. By registering to become a donor, you can have the power to save or change someone's life. One organ donor can save up to eight lives and enhance as many as 75 more through the gift of tissue.
