## Prevent Theft by Properly Locking Your Bicycle

Although achieving 100% security is impossible, properly locking your bike using a designated rack in a well-lit, high-traffic area will make it less likely to be targeted by a thief.



## Other Considerations

- Use a bike rack that has a two-point lock capability (inverted U-rack vs. comb rack).
- Purchase a bike lock that comes with insurance.
- Register your bicycle with a bike registry program or purchase Pulse ID Tags that are unique to your bike and can be scanned by police if your bike is ever stolen and recovered.

Secure **U-Lock** to rack and around bike frame through rear triangle and wheel rim. Secure cable through U-Lock and around wheel.
