


**Health Care ETHICS: The heART of Quality Care** 

## **Mission**

To foster high quality, ethical health care through research, education, and capacity building.

**Brief History:** The Centre for Health Care Ethics (CHCE) evolved out of the volunteer organization, known as Thunder Bay Bioethics Interest Group (TB-BIG), initiated in March 1996 by Dr. Jaro Kotalik. The Senate of Lakehead University approved the official creation of the Lakehead University Centre for Health Care Ethics in Fall 1998. The CHCE is a highly active and vibrant centre poised to grow, as it is still the main (and often the only) source of ethics education and support for individuals and organizations in Thunder Bay and the surrounding Northwestern Ontario region. The Centre is unique in its structural model, being based at a university but serving a large geographical area with multiple organizational partnerships across all sectors of health care service delivery. Through research, educational activities, and diverse collaborations, the CHCE is well-positioned to engage with individuals and communities to build capacity. Since January 2019, the CHCE is an institutional member and the first and only Canadian unit of the International Chair in Bioethics (ICB), World Medical Association Cooperation Centre. The CHCE Director is the Head of the Bioethics Unit and Co-Chair/International Faculty of the sub-committee of the ICB Education Department; https://edu.unesco-bioethics-chair.org/ This membership allows a global collaboration with thousands of interdisciplinary health care professionals, educators, and students.
