Re: Drug Profile Viewer (DPV) Decommissioning

Ontario Health Digital Services (formerly eHealth Ontario) in coordination with the Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care, will be decommissioning the Drug Profile Viewer (DPV) effective September 1st 2023.

The replacement for the DPV is the Ministry's **Digital Health Drug Repository (DHDR)**. The DHDR enables authorized health care providers to have secure access through provincial clinical viewers to the information previously available through DPV and more. It contains information from April 2010 to present – a significantly longer period of time than what is currently available in the DPV and provides information on publicly funded dispensed drugs and pharmacy services, as well as all monitored drugs dispensed in the province regardless of payor. This will enable the development of a Best Possible Medication History (BPMH), enhance clinical decision-making and improve patient outcomes.
