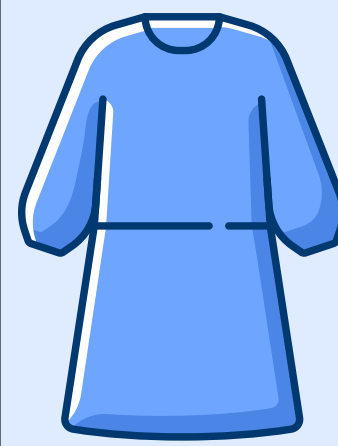
### Level 1 - Cytotoxic Hazardous Drugs

#### Preparing

- Parenteral - pharmacy will mix
- Oral Liquid - pharmacy will mix
- Oral Tablet - nitrile gloves



#### Administration



- Parenteral - nitrile gloves, impervious gown. If risk of splashing: N95 mask and eye protection

- Oral Liquid - nitrile gloves, impervious gown
- Oral Tablet - nitrile gloves



#### Disposal

For 7 days after administration the patient must be on cytotoxic precautions. Place cytotoxic sign on patient door and sticker on chart

# Level 2/3 - Hazardous Drugs & Biohazard

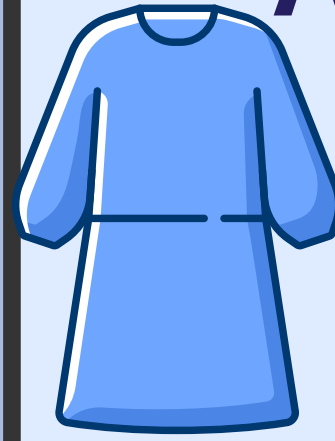
## Preparing

- Parenteral - nitrile gloves, regular gown. If risk of splashing: N95 mask and eye protection
- Oral Liquid - nitrile gloves, regular gown
- Oral Tablet - nitrile gloves



## Administration

- Parenteral - nitrile gloves, regular gown. If risk of splashing: eye protection
- Oral Liquid - nitrile gloves, regular gown
- Oral Tablet - nitrile gloves



## Disposal

Medication waste -dispose in regular pharmaceutical waste container
