Waste Disposal Guidelines

SHARPS

Sharps are any objects that are contaminated or have the potential to be contaminated with an infectious substance and are capable of penetrating skin or packaging materials

Examples of items that CAN Be Disposed:

- Needles
- Broken capillary tubes
- Syringes
- Broken rigid plastics
- Scalpels
- Lancets
- Broken glass
- Needle counters

Items that CANNOT Be Disposed

- Chemotherapeutic products
- Bandages/gauze
- Exam gloves
- Alcohol preps
- Batteries
- Tape
- Paper
- Liquids
- · Pharmaceutical waste

PHARMACEUTICAL SHARPS

Pharmaceutical sharps are any objects that are contaminated with pharmaceutical substances and are capable of penetrating skin or packaging materials. They however exclude biomedical sharps that have been in contact with blood or body fluids.

Examples of Items that CAN Be Disposed

- Pharmaceutical sharps Related items
- Pharmaceutical waste

Items that CANNOT Be Disposed

- Medical sharps
- Free Liquids
- Medical waste
- Any items visibly contaminated with blood or bodily fluids
- Cytotoxic waste
