Develop a methodology, processes and funding approach to encourage and support staff to participate in education and research.



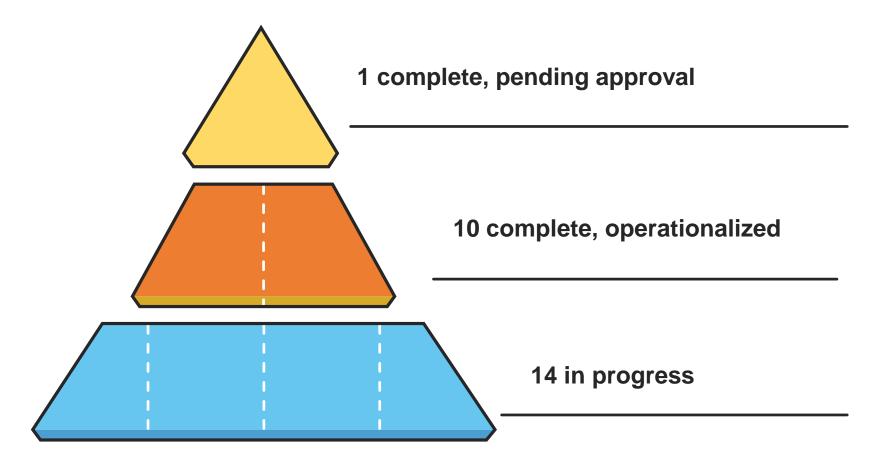
Reinforce our learning culture through development of policies, programs and communication methods that ensure staff have access to professional development resources, opportunities and supports necessary to remain effective in their roles.

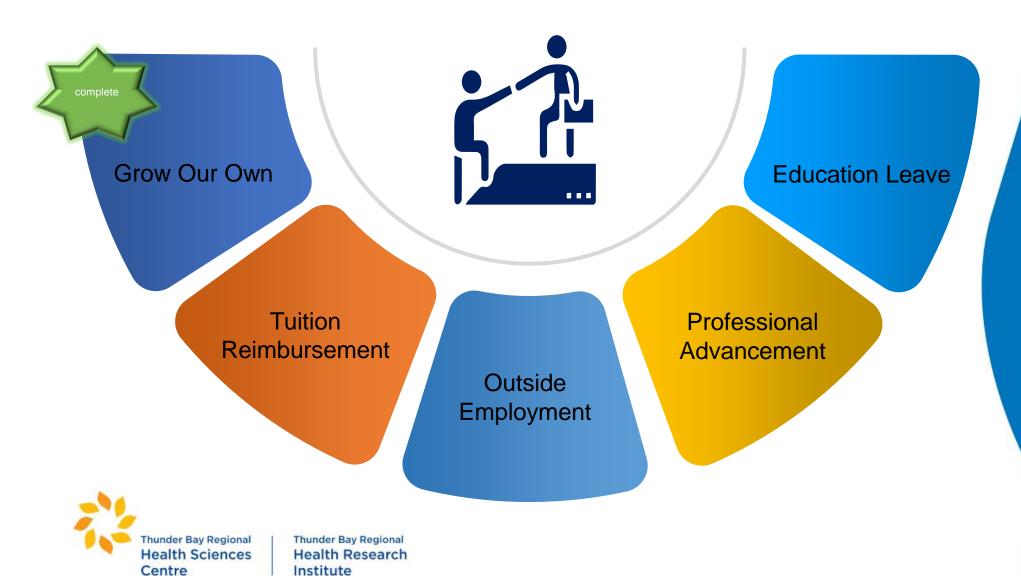


Virtual Reality platform

- Potential for other disciplines

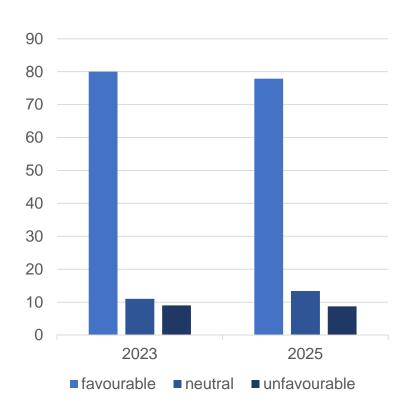

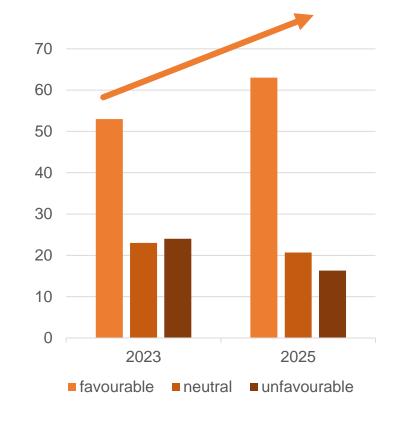
