- M365 Transition: Fall 2025 Summer 2026














STRUCTURAL INSTALLATION



IPC Strategy – Advance interprofessional collaboration at TBRHSC, to improve patient care and staff experience.



IPC Domain: Role Clarification/Negotiation

Understand and negotiate team and individual roles effectively

- Job titles visible in "To" line in Outlook
- Introduce name, role, and department in meeting
- Set clear responsibilities and accountabilities within project teams

- Interdisciplinary education on role scope
- Standardize org charts on iNtranet to have consistent leadership levels
- Update Orientation: 1) Cover role scope and areas of overlap for staff and leaders; 2) Clarify team members' role boundaries; 3) Leader training on direct reports' roles
- Hospital roles and areas in centralized repository
- 411 Process Improvement: 1) Update processes so 411 remains current; 2)
 Add new hires to 411 immediately

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IPC Domain: Team Communication

Ensure clear and respectful communication among team members

- Pair new staff with senior colleagues
- Centralized updates on hospital projects
- After incidents, have a facilitator-led debriefing to ensure respectful process
- Train staff on open-minded, respectful communication
- Train staff and managers on conflict resolution to enhance constructive communication
- Morning staff huddles to expand in scope to offer a consistent forum for open discussion

IPC Domain: Team Functioning

Optimize team efficiency and effectiveness towards shared goals

- Standardized toolkits and checklists in meetings
- Centralize IPC information on iNtranet
- Promote

 interprofessional
 success stories and
 teach IPC principles
 and practice to staff

- IPC team-building events and educational sessions
- Evaluate program
 priorities quarterly to
 optimize resource
 allocation
- Use flexible schedules and virtual meeting options

IPC Domain: Collaborative Leadership

Promote shared decision-making and accountability within the team

- Include all key collaborators from project outset
- Decision making: Include essential perspectives of frontline staff, patients, families and experts from project outset
- Collaborative change leadership training and professional development
- Frontline staff participation: 1) Ensure time and resources for involvement in initiatives as subject matter experts; 2) Create time and opportunities for leadership and frontline collaboration

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




