

This October marks six months since the launch of the Bridge Northwest Program — an important milestone in our regional journey to bring Meditech Expanse to partnering hospital organizations across Northwestern Ontario.

Since our kickoff events in April, our teams and working groups have been hard at work moving the program from planning & design into the building stage. This shift is where ideas turn into action. Validation is wrapping up, content reviews are underway, and organizations are preparing for staff to see and explore workflows in the months ahead.



At the heart of this progress are our Subject Matter Experts (SMEs). With representation from every hospital organization, these dedicated individuals bring their time, knowledge, and frontline expertise to shape how Expanse will support safe, high-quality care across the region. Whether working in clinical, technical, or support areas, SMEs have ensured that local perspectives are guiding regional design.

As we celebrate this milestone, we also look ahead. The next year will be focused on building, testing, and training — the longest stage of the program. With SMEs continuing to guide this work, and with the support of staff and leaders at every organization, Bridge Northwest is building strong foundations for a shared future in digital health.

Stage 2 - Build, Test, Train



The stages in this diagram follow the collective journey to go-live



We have now entered **Stage 2: Build, Test, Train.** This stage is about validating, building, testing, and preparing our teams for the Expanse implementation across Northwestern Ontario. Taking over a year, this is our longest stage, and where ideas turn into action.

- **Validation Wrap-up:** Working Groups will help finalize the scope of what we will see in Expanse. All organizations will be asked to sign-off on this scope during this stage.
- **Content Review:** Working Groups will perform detailed content review and customize interventions, order sets, and templates for their areas and organizations.
- **Exploration Events:** Opportunities to explore workflows, content, and hardware devices through demonstrations and consultations will be offered to staff, giving them a look at what's to come.
- **Expanded Communications:** More robust communication will begin with the introduction of Bridge Northwest Town Halls, staff involvement recognition, and leadership forums.

As the program advances, we'll continue to keep people from across the region involved and informed every step of the way.

INTERDEPENDENT PROJECTS

BUILDING THE TOOLS THAT CONNECT OUR REGION

As Bridge Northwest continues to move forward with the implementation of Meditech Expanse, several interdependent projects are also progressing to help ensure a smooth, connected, and secure transition for all 12 partner hospital organizations.

Secure Communications Tool

Work is underway to evaluate proposals for a new Secure Communications Tool — a modern, cloud-based solution that will make it easier for healthcare teams to connect with one another and coordinate patient care.



The goal is to provide a secure, reliable, and easy-to-use platform that supports physicians, nurses, health professionals, and administrative staff across the region.

Once implemented, this tool will simplify how people, groups, and resources are found, while also linking with Meditech Expanse to enable real-time updates on patient lists and care information.



The solution will operate 24/7 and become an integral part of both clinical workflows and daily operations.

Currently, Bridge
Northwest teams are in
the evaluation stage,
reviewing vendor
submissions. Top-scoring
proponents will be invited
to present live
demonstrations before a
final vendor is selected.



EHR Archive Solution

As partnering hospitals move toward the implementation of Meditech Expanse, one key consideration is what happens to the data stored in older, soon-to-be-retired systems. The Legacy Electronic Health Record (EHR) Archive Solution project is addressing this challenge by creating a safe, centralized way to store and access historical patient records.

The archive will act as a long-term, secure digital library for health information that is no longer part of active patient care but still required for legal, regulatory, and clinical reference. This includes records from older systems that have served hospitals for many years — systems that are now being replaced as part of the region's digital transformation.



The project is currently in the Request for Proposal (RFP) stage, with vendors submitting their solutions.

The program will begin evaluating proposals to identify the vendor best suited to design, implement, and manage this regional solution.


FIRST LOOK INTO EXPANSE


Change Curve Check-ins



Highlights From This Quarter

We have the foundation of our test system! We've started with a copy of standard content from the Northeast's live environment and are working through a review of all content to ensure it is correctly configured for use in the Northwest.



What's Next?

• Planning the Transition

Planning the smoothest way to move user accounts, printers, and devices into the Expanse test environment so there are minimal disruptions.

• Identifying the Gaps

Reviewing custom reports and menus used in the current system and identifying which ones need to be rebuilt or replaced in Expanse.

Front Line Survey





What's Next

In the coming quarter, we'll be working closely with the Change Specialists to share findings from both the surveys and interviews. These insights will allow them to provide more tailored support that's responsive to the specific needs of your organization.





VALIDATION

The main goal of validation is to guide how Meditech Expanse is built for the Northwest by creating clear, detailed plans for each area of work.

Phase 2 Activities

- Using expertise of SMEs in working groups.
- Identifying gaps between current state and future state.
- Reviewing complex integrated workflows and content.

What's Next

As we finalize validation work we are developing scope statements — these define what ONE HITS will build into the Expanse system based on your feedback and decisions so far. At the same time, we're identifying important changes that need to happen outside of the system, such as new workflows, role adjustments, and policy updates at each organization. Moving forward in these two parallel streams: system build and non-system work is equally important — our success at Go-Live depends on strong progress on both sides.

TECHNICAL READINESS

Over the past months, the Bridge Northwest
Technical Readiness team has been on the road,
travelling more than 3,300 kilometers across
Northwestern Ontario. Their journey began in
Thunder Bay at St. Joesph's Care Group & Thunder
Bay Regional Health Sciences Centre and then
covered stops at all 12 partner organizations, in
NWO.

With support from local IT departments, the team documented current-state technology and engaged clinical teams in discussions about their unique areas of focus. These early conversations took place while staff were still learning about what the future with Meditech Expanse will look like, but they marked an important first step in building strong relationships and gathering valuable preliminary information.



The completion of these visits represents an important milestone in preparing organizations across the region for the implementation of the new electronic health record system, Meditech Expanse.



INTEROPERABILITY

The automated exchange of data

Data Migration Plan

This quarter the Interoperability stream focused on creating a Migration Plan for data, document automation, interfaces, and robotic automation. The Migration Plan includes high level timelines to build and test interop components for Expanse.

Conductor Interface Engine

Another focus this quarter was planning an upgrade to the Conductor Interface Engine. The Test Interface Engine environment was upgraded in August and Live is expected to be upgraded in October.
