












Bridge NW – Early Access/Testing/Training

- Current access the North Bay sandbox through change specialists, for workflow validation, scoping, access to recorded demos at bridgenw.ca
- January 2026 access to HSN's Training environment for the Order Set Committee
- August 2026 broader access to the Test Environment for Integrated Testing
- January 2027 Full access to the Training Environment
- NOTE: There may be additional access during build but this is currently under discussion with ONE HITS

How will I be involved?

- Working Groups SMEs will continue to work with Bridge NW and ONE throughout the build on site specific configuration
- Order Sets the order set committee will be working until go live to review and approve order sets
- ▶ Change Activities the Change Network, alongside the hospitals, are working on the non-system changes that will be needed in 2026 to support go live (process, practice, policies)
- ► **Testing/Workflow Validation** at key decision points during 2026
- ► Activation communications events, training, data entry, device testing, setup








Bridge NW Key Dates

- Integrated Testing/Issue Remediation September 2026
- Parallel Testing/Issue Remediation December 2026
- ► Training Early 2027










