



Preceptor Recognition Program: Overview and Instructions

The Preceptor Recognition Program will run over the next few months to ensure its strategies provide sufficient opportunities to highlight and recognize preceptors at the hospital for their ongoing contributions to the teaching and learning environment. The following are ways in which learners, peers and leaders can recognize their efforts:

Coffee-Gram Recognition

In-patient managers will be provided a select number of coffee-grams that learners, peers and leaders can give to preceptors to personally recognize them for their continued efforts that contribute to a positive teaching and learning environment. In addition, for the remaining departments throughout the hospital, there will be a dedicated amount of coffee grams located in the Professional Practice office where the coffee grams can be picked up and given to preceptors by learners, peers and leaders. Preceptor of the Month

This initiative provides an opportunity for a preceptor to be recognized by learners, peers and leaders. The nomination will be an opportunity to highlight the incredible work and dedication that fosters an environment supporting growth and learning that leads to recruitment and retention. Located on the iNtranet, under quick links and on the Interprofessional Education page, is a link to a form that will be automatically submitted to the tbhsc.interprofessionaleducation@tbh.net. The form is to be submitted by the last Monday of every month. Each month the nominations will be reviewed, and one individual will be selected and recognized. They will also be entered into a draw during the Preceptor Appreciation Week (September 14th-18th). In light that all preceptors deserve to be recognized, all other nominees will be entered into a separate draw during the Preceptor Appreciation Week.

Preceptor “Thumbs Up” Page

Because preceptors do incredible work every day, why not recognize those moments in addition to submitting a nomination for preceptor of the month. On the iNtranet will be a dedicated section under the current thumbs up, where a thumbs up can be submitted for preceptors. Submissions recognizing preceptors will be displayed on iNtranet Thumbs up page. This is an opportunity for everyone to read and recognize preceptors at the TBRHSC.
