The Black Health Action Plan is an initiative that was developed by Ontario Health in order to better understand the healthcare needs of the Black population throughout Ontario, and to help improve health outcomes for Black communities. This work aligns with TBRHSC's commitment to health equity, culturally safe care, and reducing anti-Black racism at our organization.

What does participation involve?

- Completing a sociodemographic survey
- 2.5 hours in-person focus group

Candidate Criteria

We want to hear from community members, medical or healthcare trainees, physicians, and healthcare professionals who are:

- 18 years of age or older
- Live, work, and reside in Thunder Bay or Northwestern Ontario
- Have received healthcare services at a hospital in Ontario and/or specifically at TBRHSC
- Self-identify as Black

Participants will receive \$125 as an honorarium. A meal will be provided at each focus group session.
